Adventure Race Specifications

The race will include most of the adventure and leisure activities that the Outer Banks is known for:

- Kayaking
- Running
- Horse shoes
- Corn hole
- Standup Paddle boarding

Each physical activity will be followed directly after with a recreational, traditional beer drinking game to keep it low stakes, fun and unique. The race can be split up as a team event/relay or a one many show "Ironman" entrance. All teams will consist of three members: 1 kayaker, 1 SUPer and 1 runner.

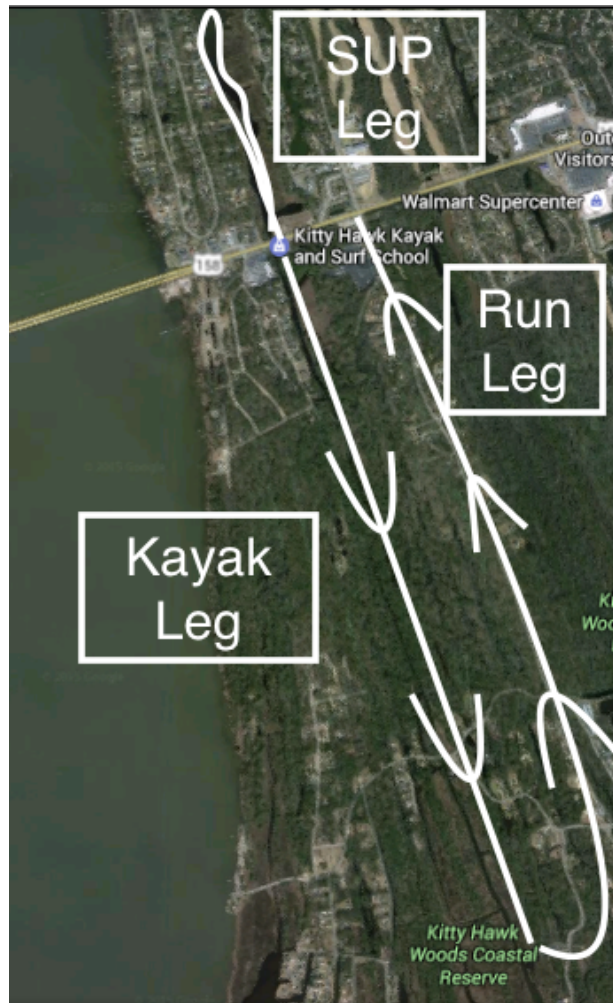
Prizes for the OBX Brewathlon Adventure Race

Breweries will have the option to sponsor teams that enter or enter the event representing their own breweries. All participants must transport one of their unopened can beers in each relay stage/leg and not loose it or drink it. The winning team gets a prize pack from brewery and ridiculous/absurd award

certificate/blue ribbon recognition, prize packs from sponsors of event/breweries/local businesses etc.

OBX Brewathlon Adventure Race Course

1. The race will begin at Kitty Hawk Kayak & Surf with a horseshoe toss contest. Participants will have to score 5 points tossing horse (leaners or rings).
2. Then race participants will hit the water and SUP north on a 1 mile loop heading north onto Jean Guite Creek.
3. Once completed, participants will then swap out their SUPs for kayaks and then paddle 2 miles south towards the Kitty Hawk Boat Launch on Bob Perry Road.
4. Participants will have to score 5 points in the corn hole toss before launching their SUPs.
5. Participants will then run 2.5 miles back north along Bob Perry Road and Woods Road to finish the race at the corner of 158 and Woods Road in Kitty Hawk.



What To Bring

Running shoes, theme music, bathing suite, good vibes, kayak, towel, friends, sunscreen, water, spirit of radness, positive attitude, stand up paddleboard, full use of your faculties, duct tape, theme music, and a lust for life. If you don't have a SUP or kayak, use of that equipment is provided free of charge with your entrance fee courtesy of Kitty Hawk Kayak & Surf School for the race.

OBX Brewfest Access

If you purchased your Brewfest Tickets in conjunction with the Brewathlon Adventure Race you will for VIP Access First Pour treatment at 1PM. Once the race concludes its time for participants to rinse off the Salt Life and head on down to Nags Head for a cold beer. (Normal access event will commence at 2 PM.)
